The price of Chinese Freshwater Cultured Pearls (CFWCPs) has risen substantially due to the increased demand. Chinese farmers have raised their prices and many buyers have returned from China with little inventory. Buyers have not yet recovered from the past years economic challenges and are not able to purchase as much as they would like.

As in previous years, CFWCPs were the main attraction of the Show. Their interesting shapes and metallic colors continue to attract buyers and customers alike. Unfortunately, soufflé pearls unveiled in 2010 are no longer available. These were non-bead, extremely large, baroque, metallic multicolor and beautiful. Pricing appears to be the same from last year but we did see new inventory.

Kasamigaura pearls are produced in less quantity and are more expensive. However, it is impossible to
tell their origin when they are side-by-side. They must be tested in a laboratory.

**Japanese Akoya Cultured Pearls** 

This year we are seeing beautiful Japanese Akoya Cultured Pearls from 4mm to 9x9.5mm. Last year, Akoyas were very hard to find and it was perplexing. This year offers pearls that are of very high luster, very round, white, no blemish, matching excellent, with the largest size being 9-9.5mm. The large sizes are very rare.

## **Tahitian South Sea Cultured Pearls**

Tahitian pearls are currently x-rayed by the authorities in order to ensure that the quality is high with thick nacre. It is now an important issue that has been taken on by the government of Tahiti. We do see more pearls than we have seen in past years and these pearls are very beautiful and rather small in size. The most important part of culturing Tahitian pearls is that the nacre is substantial and the pearls are not dyed.

## **South Sea Cultured Pearls**

South Sea cultured pearls are cultured in Australia, Indonesia, and the Philippines, which is known for the intensity of its golden pearls. Intense golden South Sea cultured pearl strands at the high end are very expensive. From what I have seen at the AGTA Show, there are a range of colors to accommodate buyer's diverse preferences.

One of the largest problems we are confronted with is distinguishing between dyed and natural colored golden pearls. It is very difficult to know if one is buying a natural South Sea golden cultured pearl necklace.

Many dealers are well aware of this and stipulate on the bill of sale as to whether the pearls have been dyed.

White South Sea Cultured Pearls are exceedingly expensive in very large sizes. The most expensive and beautiful pearls can gauge up to 20mm and can be as small as 8-9mm. These small sizes are sometimes called "baby bells" and they have a beautiful white luster. There are also commercial qualities with a middle range of white, silver white, grey, yellow and greenish pearls.
